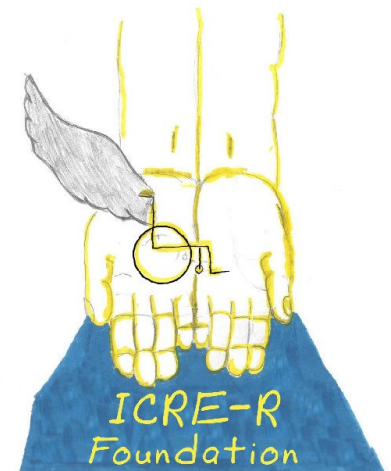

Why Does the Foundation Exist?

The Foundation is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to improving the lives of ICRE-R students. The Foundation acts as the ***funder of last resort***. Its purpose is to increase awareness of the school, and raise funds for activities or needs that are not covered by the state budget, individual or private insurance, or students' families.

Illinois Center for Rehabilitation and Education-Roosevelt

ICRE-R is a state-run residential facility for children and young adults with severe physical disabilities and/or other health impairments.

The purpose of ICRE-R is to educate, rehabilitate and prepare students with physical disabilities to transition into community life.

How Has the Foundation helped...?

The Foundation strives to help students with disabilities to empower themselves to become as independent as possible in their adult lives. Some examples of Foundation assistance include:

- **Funded transportation to allow students to experience adapted water skiing in Wisconsin**
- **Purchased supplies for students to operate a school store**
- **Purchased materials to help decorate students' living units**
- **Assisted ICRE-R's Wheels of Dreams to buy materials to start student business**
- **Assisted student in paying repair cost on wheelchair not covered by insurance**
- **Helped fund project for electric door opener to allow student independence in entering/departing apartment**
